RE: FY17 MPC Budget Amendment #1

Due to unanticipated increase (\$15,872) in MPC's Errors and Omissions Liability insurance through the Tennessee Municipal League and a required \$5,000 deductible in that policy MPC must amend the budget to reflect this increased cost. I am requesting an increase of \$21,000 to Insurance line item for a total of \$51,000 for that item. Total Insurance and Banking section of the MPC Budget will now be \$86,000.

Funds to cover this cost will come from Medical Insurance line item which will be decreased from \$371,000 to \$350,000. A decrease of \$21,000.

I recommend FY17 Budget Amendment #1 to the MPC Executive Committee and the full Commission. A copy of the revised budget is attached with the changed areas highlighted.
