SURROUNDING LAND North: Business / C-3 Commercial

NEIGHBORHOOD CONTEXT: This vacant land is within an established neighborhood of residential and

supportive commercial uses that have developed under R-1, R-1A and C-3

zones.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

► APPROVE R-1 A (Low Density Residential) zoning of all the property

This R-1A rezoning will place all the parcels into the same zone category with a residential zone that is compatible with adjoining uses. The sector plan proposes LDR for this site.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 5/8/2007 and 5/22/2007. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.
