▶ APPROVE the closure of the unnamed alley, subject to any required easements.


This alley is an unimproved right of way and is not needed for public access in this area.

COMMENTS:


The closure of this unimproved and unnamed alley will allow the owner to claim the former public right of way for private development. The same party owns the three parcels which abut this right of way.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 2/13/2007 and 2/27/2007. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.
