# **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

APPROVE the amendments to the City of Knoxville Downtown Design Review Board Administrative Rules and Procedures

### **BACKGROUND:**

As part of the Downtown Design Overlay District one year update process for City Council, MPC staff and the Downtown Design Review Board have proposed multiple modifications/additions to the Downtown Knoxville Design Guidelines. One of which requires the amendment to the Administrative Rules and Procedures to include delegating to staff the authority to approve the demolition of non-historic building features on publicly-oriented facades and historic building features to be replaced inkind. This is to allow for the expedited approval of applications that are minor in nature and meet the guidelines.

# AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION 2, OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE DOWNTOWN DESIGN REVIEW BOARD ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND PROCEDURES, DELEGATING TO STAFF THE AUTHORITY TO APPROVE APPLICATIONS FOR DEMOLITIONS THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE DESIGN GUIDELINES AND THE PROVISIONS OF THE KNOXVILLE ZONING ORDINANCE

(Old language is struck though, and new language is in **bold type**.)

Article VII. Section 2. RESPONSIBILITIES

Pursuant to Article 4, Section 26, the Board hereby delegates to staff the authority to approve applications for new signs, **demolition of non-historic features on publicly-oriented facades, demolition of historic features to be replaced in-kind,** replacement of windows at ground level with transparent glass, or other replacements that are consistent with the Design Guidelines and the provisions of the Knoxville Zoning Ordinance.
