APPROVE the closure


This narrow street segment is not needed for private traffic access on E. Church Ave., but is needed for safe bus storage within the new public transit facility.

COMMENTS:

If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.


AT&T has facilities in this area. The closing will be satisfactory as originally proposed with an easement to maintain and replace our plant as needed in the area in question.
