APPROVE the closure subject to any required easements requested.


This closure will permit the relocation of the City's central public transit facilities to the adjoining property and is needed to meet the public transportation needs of residents within the greater Knoxville area.

Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.

Re: Right-of-Way Closure Request 6-A-08-CC

We have reviewed our records and find that we have existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way. The approximate location of these facilities is indicated on the attached prints. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing utility facilities, whether or not shown on these prints.

Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easement for its utility facility.

Gas – 12.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the gas line, 25 feet total width Water – 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the water line, 15 feet total width
