Place Blvd also allow us to name an Edwards Place side street King Edwards Court for historical reasons. This is being requested to honor King Edward I commonly known as one of the top 100 greatest Britton's in English history. Edward I (17 June 1239 - 7 July 1307), popularly known as Longshanks, also as "Edward the Lawgiver" or "the English Justinian" because of his legal reforms, and as "Hammer of the Scots", achieved fame as the monarch who conquered Wales and tried (but failed) to do the same to Scotland.
