STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

APPROVE the street name 'Everly Way.'

The proposed street name is not a duplication and meets all requirements of the Knox County Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance.

COMMENTS:

This private joint permanent easement is approximately 10 feet wide and serves five residential lots and a church. All property owners along the easement have signed the 'Street Name Change Canvass Form', indicating agreement with this proposed name change.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 1/25/2010. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 30 days to appeal an MPC decision in the County.

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
