APPROVE the proposed amendments to the One Year Plan map.


Comments:

As part of the 2008 One Year Plan Update, staff proposed to update the map to reflect a more appropriate designation for various major rights of way throughout the City. A new plan designation, called ROW (Major Rights of Way)was created as part of that update, which was to be assigned to appropriate areas.

This proposal is to redesignate certain rights of way on the One Year Plan map as ROW from their current designation, which is OS (Open Space). Clearly, ROW is a more appropriate designation for these major highways than OS. The rights of way proposed to be changed are all currently designated OS. They are shown generally on the attached map and are listed below:

- Sections of I-40/75 west of I-640 interchange
- Sections of I-40 east of I-640 interchange
- Sections of I-275 and I-75 north of downtown
- Sections of I-640
- Sections of I-140/Pellissippi Parkway
- Sections of Alcoa Highway/US-129 south of I-40
- Sections of James White Parkway
