FOR CHANGE: To correct a long standing address and street name issue. This

change will allow addresses in use to correspond to the correct

street name. No addresses will change.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

APPROVE the name change to Forest Hills Blvd.

The property owners on this road section are already using the Forest Hills name, and this will clear up a long standing street name issue for this neighborhood.

COMMENTS:

This change will provide the same street name for what appears to be a continuous street section.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 7/14/2009 and 7/28/2008. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.
