► RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure, subject to any required easements.


Staff has received no objections to this closure. The closure of this portion of Century St. will not adversely impact public access to property in the area.

COMMENTS:

The City of Knoxville proposes to consolidate all the individual parcels for redevelopment of the site. The closure of this and several other rights-of-way in this area are necessary in order to consolidate all the property. In this area, there are four other right-of-way closure proposals by the City also on this agenda.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 3/9/2010 and 3/23/2010. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.
