STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

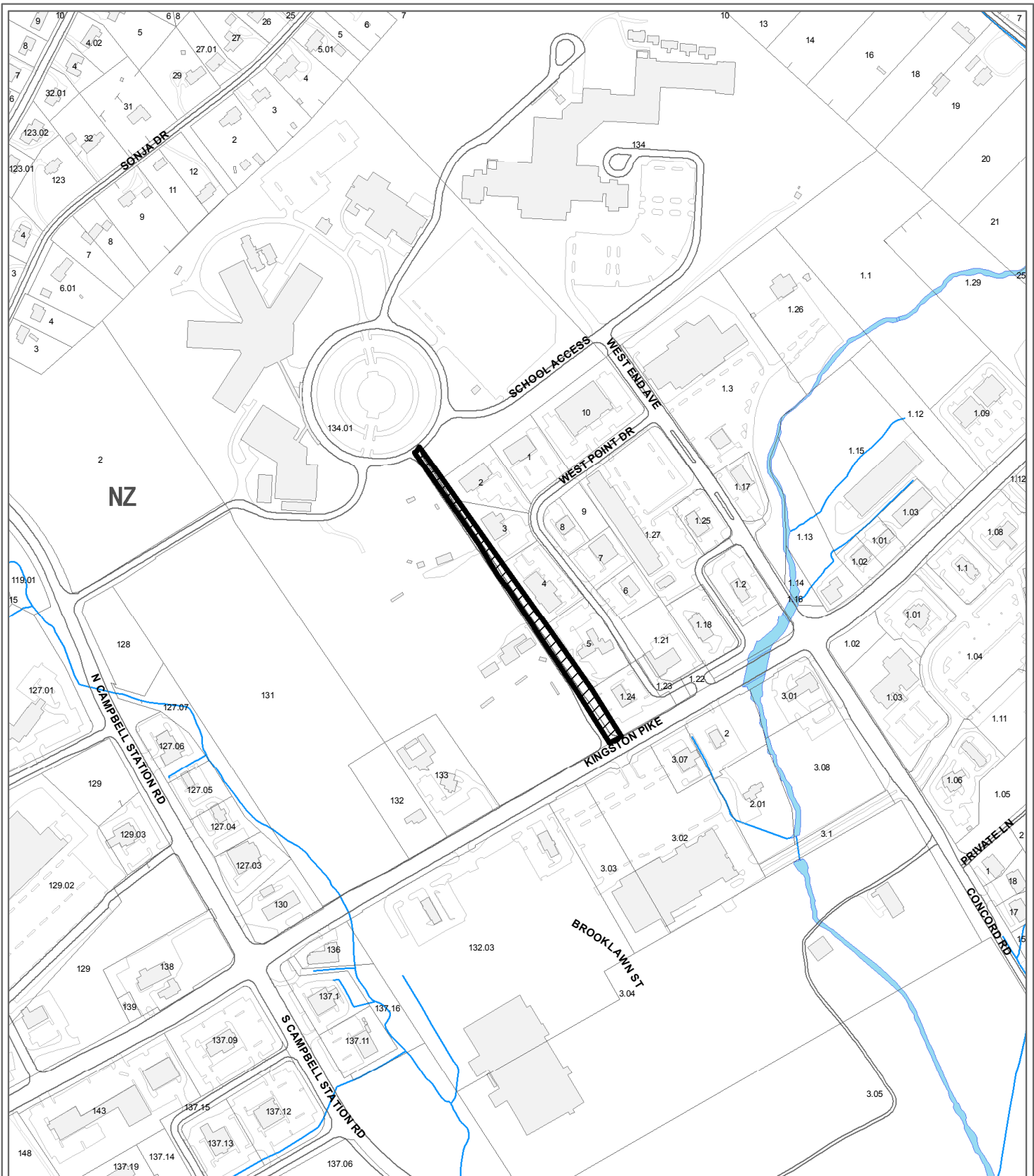
▶ **APPROVE** the name 'Lendon Welch Way.'
