► RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure of the unnamed alley, subject to any required easements.


Staff has received no objections to this closure. The applicant has obtained signatures from all adjoining property owners, including the school board, indicating agreement with the request.

COMMENTS:

The Knox County Board of Education voted to approve a resolution to close this alley adjacent to Sequoyah Elementary School at their regular session meeting on June 2, 2010.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 10/5/2010 and 10/19/2010. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.

Re: Right-of-Way Closure Request 9-A-10-AC

We have reviewed our records and find that we have existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way. The approximate location of these facilities is indicated on the enclosed prints. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing utility facilities, whether or not shown on these prints.

Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easement for its utility facility.

Electric - 10 feet on each side of the centerline of the electric line, 20 feet total width Sewer - 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the wastewater line, 15 feet total width

So long as these conditions are met, KUB has no objection to the closure of this right-of-way. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please call me at (865) 558-2291.



A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF KNOX COUNTY, TENNESSEE, IN SUPPORT OF THE CLOSURE OF AN UNNAMED ALLEY BORDERING SEQUOYAH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, there presently exists an unnamed alley 22 feet in width running from the south line of Iskagna Drive approximately 1,188 feet southerly to its terminus at the rear of lots fronting on Keowee Avenue in the City of Knoxville (the "Alley"); and

WHEREAS, the Alley lies between the property of Knox County, being the Sequoyah Elementary School property, and Lots 1 through 18 of the Terry Arnold Manor Subdivision, as shown on the map of same recorded in Map Cabinet A, Slide 288-D, in the Knox County Register's Office; and

WHEREAS, the owners of Lots 1 through 18 of Terry Arnold Manor Subdivision abutting on the east side of the Alley desire to petition for its closure upon the condition that upon closure by the City of Knoxville, the underlying fee simple title thereto shall vest one-balf in the owners on each side thereof; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution dated June 2, 2010, the Knox County Board of Education resolved not to oppose a petition to close the Alley; and

WHEREAS, Knox County recognizes that the Alley has never been closed by the City of Knoxville and that any ownership rights it may have therein is limited to the western one-half and extend only to the centerline of the Alley from the Sequoyah Elementary School property; and

WHEREAS, the Knox County Commission desires to affirm the foregoing recitations and consent to the closure of the Alley and the division of the same as herein stated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF KNOX COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Knox County does not and will not oppose a petition to the Metropolitan Planning Commission and the Knoxville City Council to close the Alley.
- 2. Knox County makes no claim to the ownership of the underlying fee simple title to the portion of the Alley lying on the east side of the centerline thereof.
- 3. Upon closure of the Alley by the City of Knoxville, the eastern one-half shall be quit claimed to the owners of the adjacent lots in Terry Arnold Manor Subdivision, and the western one-half shall be quit claimed to Knox County as part of the Sequoyah Elementary School property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any notifications are to be made to effectuate this Resolution, then the County Clerk is hereby requested to forward a copy of this Resolution to the proper authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution is to take effect from and after its passage, as provided by the Charter of Knox County, Tennessee, the public welfare requiring it.
