▶ **APPLICANT'S REASON FOR CHANGE:** Mr. Jones is Knox County's Director of Veteran's Affairs and has served with distinction for many years. Dade Drive is one of the primary approaches to the Veteran's Nursing Home, currently has no listed addresses and is an appropriate choice for recognizing Mr. Jones' service.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

▶ **APPROVE** the street name 'Chuck Jones Drive'.

The proposed street name is not a duplication and meets all applicable requirements of the Knox County Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance.

**COMMENTS:**

Dade Dr. is a short segment of right-of-way (700 feet), which does not extend beyond the section proposed to be renamed. The proposed name change will have very little impact. The owner of all the adjacent property has provided a signed letter to Knox County, indicating agreement with the proposed name change. No property addresses will change as a result of this name change.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knox County Commission for action on 6/27/2011. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knox County Commission. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 30 days to appeal an MPC decision in the County.

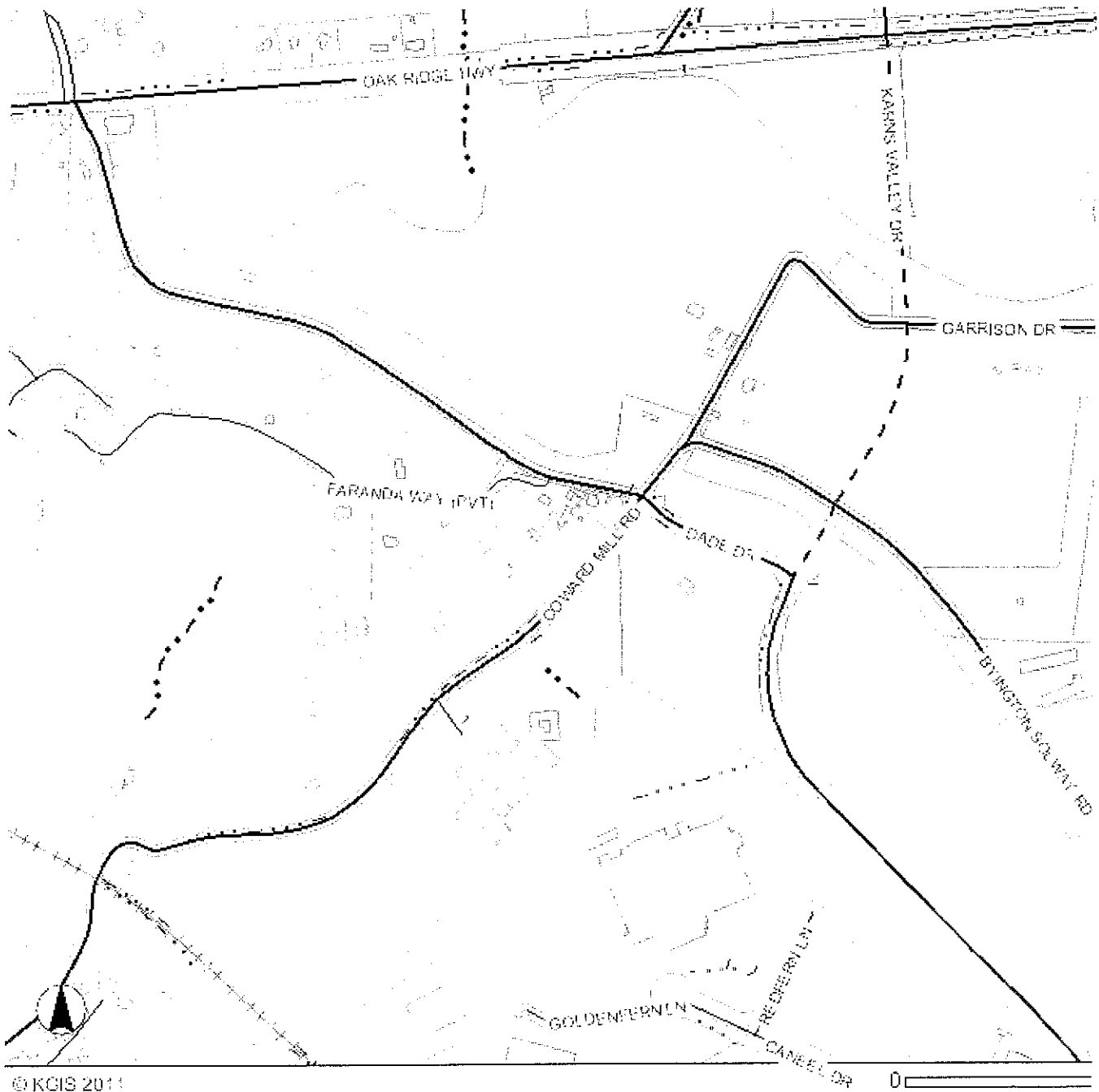

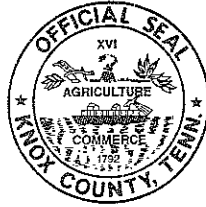

Thank-you again for giving so generously of your time during our conversation a few weeks back. I hope this finds you well, and perhaps enjoying better weather than your friends in the eastern part of the state

I have gathered a bit more information for you regarding our Veteran's Services Director, Mr. Chuck Jones, and enclosed a recent picture as well.

Chuck was born in Knoxville in April of 1929. In 1945, he joined the Navy at the age of 17, having not been entirely honest with the Naval recruiters about his age! He was pressed into service as a cook, and served during both World War II and the Korean War. During his Naval career, he sailed on the following ships:

USS Washington BB56  
USS Trathen DD530  
USS Talladega APA 208  
USS Piper SS-409  
USS Jallao SS-368  
USS Grouper SS-214

In 1965, Chuck retired from active duty. He subsequently went to work for the Federal Government and helped open the Kings Bay Navy Submarine Base in St. Mary's, Georgia. Around 1986, he came to work at Knox County as our Veteran's Service Officer and has been serving our veteran's community ever since. He remains involved with the American Legion, the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), the East Tennessee Military Affairs Council, and was actively involved in the efforts to bring the Ben Atchley Veteran's Home to Knox County. Finally, on a personal note, he is among the nicest people you might ever hope to meet.


