STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure of a portion of Dawn St., as requested, subject to any required easements.


Staff has received no objections to this closure. The applicant owns parcel 5 to the west of the R-O-W and has received written agreement on the closure from the owner of parcel 1 to the east of the R-O-W.

COMMENTS:

Dawn St. is a right-of-way that runs from Richmond Ave. to Truman Ave. The only improved section is just north of Truman Ave., where there is about 100 feet of pavement within the right-of-way. The proposed section for closure is a paper street only. It has not been improved in any way and is likely too steep to construct a paved road. The City of Knoxville Engineering Department and other agencies have reviewed the proposal, and no objections have been raised.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 1/8/2013 and 1/22/2013. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.

Re: Right-of-Way Closure Request 12-C-12-SC Block No. 23362 CLT No. 94 Parcel No. 5

We have reviewed our records and find that we have existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way. The approximate location of these facilities is indicated on the enclosed prints. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing utility facilities, whether or not shown on these prints.

Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easement for its utility facility.

Sewer - 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the wastewater line, 15 feet total width

So long as these conditions are met, KUB has no objection to the closure of this right-of-way. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please call me at (865) 558-2291.


