► APPLICANT'S REASON

FOR CLOSURE:

To consolidate area of right-of-way that was dedicated per plat recorded as Instrument No. 201301140045950. The right-of-way area was dedicated to satisfy minimum turning radius requirements at a street intersection. However, this area is not needed due to abutting portion of Dawn St. being closed per Ordinance O-13-2013. Area will

be consolidate into existing lot 190R1or CLT094HQ00502.

► RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure of this portion of Dawn Street, as requested, subject to any required easements:


Staff has received no objections from reviewing departments to this closure.

COMMENTS:

The closure of this small portion of Dawn Street right-of-way, as proposed, will allow the right-of-way to be added into the adjacent lot (parcel 094HQ00502). The subject area of right-of-way was dedicated by plat to meet minimum turn radius requirements at a street intersection. However, with the recent closure of Dawn St. this remnant piece of right-of way is no longer needed. Staff has not heard from any opposition to this closure as of the date of this report.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 8/6/2013 and 8/20/2013. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.

We have reviewed our records and find that we have existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way. The approximate location of these facilities is indicated on the enclosed prints. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing utility facilities, whether or not shown on these prints.

Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easement for its utility facility.

Electric – 10 feet on each side of the centerline of the electric line, 20 feet total width Sewer – 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the wastewater line, 15 feet total width

So long as these conditions are met, KUB has no objection to the closure of this right-of-way. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please call me at (865) 558-2291.




