I want to express my concerns about the proposed development, in addition to my previous letter, in regard to the projected 1500 automobile trips on Shackleford Lane. There are various narrow spots that require cars to slow or stop to let the other car pass. When I am in my truck and meet another vehicle, I always must stop to let the other vehicle pass. There are also several blind hills on Shackleford Lane and Graves Road. With the proposed increase in traffic, I fear for my family's safety as they traverse this section of road.

Also, I am concerned this development will be started, only a few homes will be built and the project will then be left unfinished and unattractive. This is the case with Graysburg, a subdivision only a few miles from Shackleford Lane off Ruggles Ferry Road.

My request is that the number of homes in the proposed development be consistent with the surrounding country side (most homes are on lots 2 acres or larger).
