APPLICANT'S REASON FOR CLOSURE:	Very sparsely used street. Closure will help adjacent owners redevelop adjacent parcels for new retail uses and allow for reconfiguration and sufficient parking to serve retailers as required by code. The closure will allow the right-of-way to return to the City and County tax rolls.		
DEPARTMENT-UTILITY REPORTS:	No objections from any departments or utilities have been received by staff as of the date of this report.		

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure of Ben Atchley St., as requested, subject to any required easements.


Staff has received no objections from reviewing departments to this closure. The applicant has control of the two parcels to the east and west of the right-of-way.

COMMENTS:

The closure of the street, as proposed, will allow the two adjacent parcels to be combined into one larger site that would be more suitable for commercial development, as permitted by the zoning. Staff has received phone calls from an adjacent property owner on the south side of Homberg Dr., indicating opposition to the proposal. However, that property does not front on Ben Atchley St. The only two parcels that have frontage or Ben Atchley St. are controlled by the applicant.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 4/16/2013 and 4/30/2013. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.

We have reviewed our records and find that we have existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way. The approximate location of these facilities is indicated on the enclosed prints. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing utility facilities, whether or not shown on these prints.

Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easement for its utility facility.

Gas – 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the gas line, 15 feet total width

So long as these conditions are met, KUB has no objection to the closure of this right-of-way. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please call me at (865) 558-2291.


