STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

▶ **RECOMMEND** that City Council **APPROVE** the closure of this unnamed alley, as requested, subject to any required easements:

This alley is unimproved right-of-way and is not needed for access to any parcels. Once closed, the right-of-way will be consolidated with the surrounding parcels for redevelopment of the City's Loraine Street facilities. The City of Knoxville owns all of the adjacent properties.

COMMENTS:

The applicant reports that this closure is needed to provide space to accommodate proposed public service and civil engineering facility at Loraine Street.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 4/15/2014 and 4/29/2014. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.



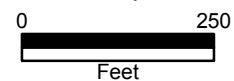
