 - 1. The 2 conditions included in the attached letter from City of Knoxville Engineering (dated November 3, 2014) must be addressed to the satisfaction of that department.


With the above condition included, staff has received no objections from reviewing departments or utilities to this closure.


COMMENTS:

The applicant has control of all properties adjacent to the right-of-way. If approved, the ownership of the right-of-way would be transferred to the adjacent property owners.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 12/9/2014 and 12/23/2014. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.





Mr. Brusseau:

The City Engineering Department has no objections to close the above described right-of-way areas provided the following conditions, subject to City Engineering approval, are met:

- 1. The applicant shall agree to adjust the closure area to allow ingress/egress from intersecting Hedge Ave to the portion of Twelfth St remaining open, which is near the intersection of Forest Ave. This adjusted closure area will be all of the portion of Twelfth St running from the southern right-of-way line of World's Fair Park Drive and bounded on the south, by a new severance line, running from the southwestern most corner of CLT 094LM004.00 (Deed Inst. No. 200903110056817) to the southwest corner of CLT 094LM007.00 (Deed Inst. No. 200510040030873). Please, see the attached exhibit map for a representation of the intended closure area.
- 2. Should this right-of-way area be closed, the City will reserve easements for all drainage facilities and utilities, if any, located in or within five (5) feet of the property described herein.



We have reviewed our records and find that we have existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way. The approximate location of these facilities is indicated on the enclosed prints. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing utility facilities, whether or not shown on these prints.

Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easement for its utility facility.

Electric - 10 feet on each side of the centerline of the electric line, 20 feet total width Gas - 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the gas line, 15 feet total width Water - 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the water line, 15 feet total width
