If the Commission would like to add that condition, I don't have any concern with that. However, I do not feel it is necessary because of the unrestricted signs that would be allowed in the nearby CA and CB zones. The recommended CR does have requirement for a monument sign of 6 ft max height and 60 sq ft in area, but does allow direct illumination. Nearby zones have no such restrictions.
