Dear Members of Knoxville-Knox County Metropolitan Planning Commission:

There were a few issues raised regarding Cell Towers at the Agenda Review Meeting. We wanted to try to address those questions in regards to the application for a tower proposed for the corner of Bluegrass and Garland Roads. (5-C-15-UR)

• Flush Mounted Antennae vs. Platforms or "Bird Cage/Basket" Mounted Antennae

(Will flush mounted antennae cause more towers?)

- Initially T-Mobile can work with 1 level of flush mounted antennae at this site
- o Requirements for flush mounted antenna may differ from site to site based on the carrier, the coverage, the topography and the technology.
- One level of antennae may not always work for flush mounts and it may not work for other carriers at this site
- Can T-Mobile gain the coverage they need from existing towers?
 - o Unfortunately, T- Mobile cannot obtain the needed coverage from existing towers.
 - Attached is a map that shows towers in the Bluegrass area.
 - T-Mobile is located on all of these towers, except the towers located at Sandpiper Lane and in the Louisville area.
 - The Sandpiper Lane tower was approved with 4 levels of antennae; and it has 4 levels of antennae on it now.
 - o T-Mobile looked at the Sandpiper Tower before proposing this tower and tried to make it work, but the level available on this tower will not provide the coverage T-

o The Louisville tower is over 2 miles away and will not provide the coverage needed.

How many antennae arrays are required on this tower?

- The Knox County Code says that towers over 130 feet must provide for at least 3 antenna arrays
- Branch's Site Plan for Garland/Bluegrass provides for 4 antennae arrays.
- o Branch Communications is a tower company, not a carrier -- their objective is to lease space to as many carriers as possible on each tower.

RA Zoning

- While the Bluegrass site is currently zoned as RA, it has a pasture and the owner has farm animals.
- Many of the surrounding properties are zoned Agriculture. The zoning map is attached.
- $_{\odot}$ The proposed location is on a 7+ acre parcel of land and has good buffering and many trees.
