► RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure of a portion of the unnamed alley, as requested, subject to any required easements.


This alley is partially paved and partially covered by a building. It is not needed for access to any parcels. Once closed, the right-of-way will be consolidated with the surrounding parcels for redevelopment. The applicant owns or has agreement from owners of all the adjacent properties.


COMMENTS:

There are discrepancies between the parcel map and the City ward map in regards to this alley's location. The agenda map shows the alley location as depicted on the City ward map, but City Engineering reports that there may be some unclosed right-of-way to the north as well, as depicted on the attached zoning/parcel map, between parcels 12 and 13 and parcel 14. These situations arise often because of the deeding, rather than platting of property during property transfers. Regardless, MPC and City Engineering staffs support the closure of all public rights-of-way within the block between Randolph St., Humes St., E. Depot Ave. and the railroad, and if approved as recommended, that will be the result of the approval. The applicant reports that this closure is needed for the reopening of loading dock areas at 201 Randolph St.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 7/7/2015 and 7/21/2015. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.
