NEIGHBORHOOD CONTEXT: The site is located on the eastern edge of an existing area of detached

dwellings. This site is north of West High School and the TN National Guard

Armory.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

USE AND ZONING:

► WITHDRAW as requested by the applicant

COMMENTS:

This request comes to you under unusual circumstances. A church was located on this site until it suffered significant fire damage which resulted in the building being demolished. Since there is no record of the church ever having been approved, it lost its preexisting nonconforming status when the building was torn down. The

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applicant is now requesting approval of a use on review in order to permit the reconstruction of the church.

The applicant requested this matter be withdrawn on 8/25/15.

ESTIMATED TRAFFIC IMPACT: 201 (average daily vehicle trips)

Average Daily Vehicle Trips are computed using national average trip rates reported in the latest edition of "Trip Generation," published by the Institute of Transportation Engineers. Average Daily Vehicle Trips represent the total number of trips that a particular land use can be expected to generate during a 24-hour day (Monday through Friday), with a "trip" counted each time a vehicle enters or exits a proposed development.

ESTIMATED STUDENT YIELD: Not applicable.

MPC's approval or denial of this request is final, unless the action is appealed to the Knoxville City Council. The date of the Knoxville City Council hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.

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
