► RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure of a portion of McCormick St., as requested, subject to any required easements.


Staff has received no objections from reviewing departments or utilities to this closure.

### **COMMENTS:**

If approved for closure, the right-of-way will be consolidated with the adjacent parcels and converted to private property. The applicant owns all parcels adjacent to this right-of-way. Having not received any objections to the closure, MPC staff recommends approval, as requested.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 7/5/2016 and 7/19/2016. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.

We have reviewed our records and find that we have existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way. The approximate location of these facilities is indicated on the enclosed prints. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing utility facilities, whether or not shown on these prints.

Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easement for its utility facility.

Water - 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the water line, 15 feet total width
