Thanks for your tremendous help on this ordinance. As you know, we encountered several difficulties in crafting a one-size-fits-all approach with this ordinance, especially in distinguishing between the urban and suburban variety within C-3. Additionally, Camiros has indicated that they will be incorporating more flexibility for temporary uses in the code update. Accordingly, we have come up with a solution to allow this use in a particular location in a temporary fashion; this will allow us to assess the use's function and needs without trying to divine them and draft an amendment. Please withdraw the food truck park ordinance. Thanks again for lending your expertise on this.
