► RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure of the requested portion of the unnamed alley, subject to any required easements.


Staff has received no objections from reviewing departments or utilities to this closure.

#### **COMMENTS:**

If approved for closure, the right-of-way will be combined with the adjacent tracts and converted to private property. The applicant owns all of properties adjacent to the subject right-of-way. Having not received any objections to the closure, MPC staff recommends approval, as requested.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 1/16/2018 and 1/30/2018. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.


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

#### REQUIRED SIGN POSTING AGREEMENT FORM

For all rezoning, plan amendment, concept plan, use on review, BZA variance, right-of-way closure, and street name change applications, a sign must be posted on the subject property, consistent with the adopted MPC/BZA Administrative Rules and Procedures. When applicable, MPC staff will provide a sign to post on the property at the time of application.

The sign must be posted in a location that is clearly visible from the nearest adjacent street. If the property has more than one street frontage, then the sign should be placed along the higher classified street. MPC staff may recommend a preferred location for the sign to be posted at the time of application.

The sign must be posted no later than two weeks prior to the scheduled MPC/BZA hearing and must remain in place until after the meeting. In the case of a postponement, the sign can either remain in place or be removed and reposted no later than two weeks prior to the next MPC/BZA meeting.

MPC staff will provide the first sign(s) for no additional charge as part of the application fees. If the sign(s) are lost or stolen and need to be replaced, then the applicant will be responsible for picking up a new sign from the MPC offices. The applicant will be charged a replacement fee for the second sign consistent with the agency's cost of purchasing each sign.
