Staff has received no objections from reviewing departments or utilities to this closure.



If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision in the City.

Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easement for its utility facilities.

Electric -10 feet on each side of the centerline of the electric line, 20 feet total width Gas -7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the gas line, 15 feet total width




Right-of-Way Closure Area for UNNAMED ALLEY











The Knox County tax records and a recent title examination show that you own property cited above. This property is in the vicinity of the Clifton Road development site. This site is in the planning stage for future development of affordable housing.

In order to complete this project, it will be necessary for the City to close some of the platted roads in the development area. A number of these road exist only on paper.

The City, in cooperation with Knoxville's Community Development Corporation has contracted with Cannon & Cannon, Inc. to design preliminary plans and conceptual site plans for the project.

A survey has also been conducted to determine any possible encroachments or property line discrepancies.

For your information, I am enclosing a copy of the Right of Way Closure Application that will be submitted to the MPC, along with some other plans that will help define the Clifton Road Development site.
