► RECOMMEND that City Council APPROVE the closure of the requested portion of Ambrose Street, subject to any required easements.


Staff has received no objections from reviewing departments or utilities to this closure, and is therefore recommending approval. Furthermore, this section of Ambrose Street is a paper street that was never developed within the Lonsdale neighborhood and there are no future plans to develop a road within this right-of-way.

COMMENTS:

The City of Knoxville Engineering Department and City of Knoxville Fire Department has no objection to the proposed right-of-way closure. An attached August 24, 2018 letter from City Engineering describes their standard policy regarding right-of-way closures and utility easements. Staff has not received any objections to this closure.

Each adjacent property owner will take ownership of 50% of the right-of-way, upon closure. The adjacent property owners have agreed to the closure.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 10/9/2018 and 10/23/2018. If denied, MPC's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal an MPC decision.

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
REQUIRED SIGN POSTING AGREEMENT

For all rezoning, plan amendment, concept plan, use on review, right-of-way closure, and street name change applications, a sign must be posted on the subject property, consistent with the adopted MPC Administrative Rules and Procedures.

At the time of application, MPC staff will provide a sign(s) to post on the property as part of the application process. If the sign(s) go missing for any reason and need to be replaced, then the applicant will be responsible for picking up a new sign(s) from the MPC offices. The applicant will be charged a fee of \$10 for each replacement sign.

LOCATION AND VISIBILITY

The sign must be posted in a location that is clearly visible from vehicles traveling in either direction on the nearest adjacent/frontage street. If the property has more than one street frontage, then the sign should be placed along the street that carries more traffic. MPC staff may recommend a preferred location for the sign to be posted at the time of application.



TIMING

The sign(s) must be posted 15 days before the scheduled MPC public hearing and must remain in place until the day after the meeting. In the case of a postponement, the sign can either remain in place or be removed and reposted 15 days before the next MPC meeting.
