STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the name change to "Joseph Schofield Street"

The proposed street name is not a duplication and meets all requirements of the City of Knoxville Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance.

COMMENTS:

1. Due to TDOT Project #: HPPS/STP/NH-62(34) realigning a portion of Western Avenue, the unnamed alley between Keith and Richmond Avenues requires a street name for addressing purposes.

2. The City's Office of Neighborhoods obtained input from the community, who recommended using Joseph Schofield to honor one of the original developers in the area. Staff is therefore recommending the name Joseph Schofield Street for the unnamed alley.

3Any property using this ROW for access will be readdressed with the new street name.

4. Since a new street name is necessary due to the TDOT project referenced, no authorization was required of surrounding property owners, though they were informed.

5. Staff has received no objections to the renaming of this right-of-way.

6. It meets all requirements of the "Addressing Guidelines and Procedures" section of Knoxville-Knox County's Administrative Rules and Procedures as well as those in the City of Knoxville's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23, Article IV, Section 23-108.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 10/8/2019 and 10/22/2019. If denied, Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal a Planning Commission decision in the City.

REQUIRED SIGN POSTING AGREEMENT

For all rezoning, plan amendment, concept plan, use on review, right-of-way closure, and street name change applications, a sign must be posted on the subject property, consistent with the adopted MPC Administrative Rules and Procedures.

At the time of application, MPC staff will provide a sign(s) to post on the property as part of the application process. If the sign(s) go missing for any reason and need to be replaced, then the applicant will be responsible for picking up a new sign(s) from the MPC offices. The applicant will be charged a fee of \$10 for each replacement sign.

LOCATION AND VISIBILITY

The sign must be posted in a location that is clearly visible from vehicles traveling in either direction on the nearest adjacent/frontage street. If the property has more than one street frontage, then the sign should be placed along the street that carries more traffic. MPC staff may recommend a preferred location for the sign to be posted at the time of application.



TIMING

The sign(s) must be posted 15 days before the scheduled MPC public hearing and must remain in place until the day after the meeting. In the case of a postponement, the sign can either remain in place or be removed and reposted 15 days before the next MPC meeting.
