Road was never constructed or used by the public.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

► Approve closure of Herman Avenue from Timothy Avenue to Rutledge Pike from the property line of parcel 070LC001 to the midpoint of parcel 070MC016, subject to any required easements, since it is undeveloped and staff has received no objections.

COMMENTS:

- 1. The right-of-way runs from Timothy Avenue south to Rutledge Pike. It is undeveloped and does not provide access to any lots. The Addressing Department has confirmed its closure will not impact any existing addresses.
- 2. Staff has received no objections, but the following departments and organizations had these comments:
 - a. KUB: We have reviewed our records and find that we have existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way. The approximate locations of these facilities are indicated on the enclosed prints. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing utility facilities, whether or not shown on these prints. Should this right-of-way be closed, KUB will require the following permanent easements for its utility facilities:
 - i. Sewer 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the sewer lines, 15 feet total width
 - ii. Gas 7.5 feet on each side of the centerline of the gas lines, 15 feet total width
 - b. The City Engineering Department has no objections to close the above described right-of-way area.



However, should this right-of-way be closed, the City will reserve easements for all drainage facilities and utilities, if there are any current facilities, located in or within five (5) feet of the property described herein. No easements are reserved if there are no current facilities within the closure area. If any existing facilities or utilities are found not feasible to the site development or use, they may be removed and relocated, subject to City Engineering and/or other applicable easement holder review and approval.

- c. The City's Fire Department had no comments.
- d. TDOT had no Comments as the right-of-way does not appear to affect state assets.
- e. AT&T does not wish to relinquish any ROW or utility easements at this time.

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 9/8/2020 and 9/22/2020. If denied, Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal a Planning Commission decision in the City.


REQUIRED SIGN POSTING AGREEMENT

For all rezoning, plan amendment, concept plan, use on review, right-of-way closure, and street name change applications, a sign must be posted on the subject property, consistent with the adopted Administrative Rules and Procedures.

At the time of application, staff will provide a sign(s) to post on the property as part of the application process. If the sign(s) go missing for any reason and need to be replaced, then the applicant will be responsible for picking up a new sign(s) from the Planning offices. The applicant will be charged a fee of \$10 for each replacement sign.

LOCATION AND VISIBILITY

The sign must be posted in a location that is clearly visible from vehicles traveling in either direction on the nearest adjacent/frontage street. If the property has more than one street frontage, then the sign should be placed along the street that carries more traffic. Planning staff may recommend a preferred location for the sign to be posted at the time of application.



TIMING

The sign(s) must be posted 15 days before the scheduled Planning Commission public hearing and must remain in place until the day after the meeting. In the case of a postponement, the sign can either remain in place or be removed and reposted 15 days before the next Planning Commission meeting.
