STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Approve closure of the unnamed alley that runs from Hart Avenue to the southwest corner of parcel 094OC028, subject to any required easements, since it does not provide access to any lots and staff has received no objections.

COMMENTS:

1. The alley was never developed, so this is a right-of-way that does not provide access to any parcels. 2. This request is to close an "L" shaped alley located mid-block between Twenty-third Street and Alcoa Highway.

- 3. A previous right-of-way closure was granted for the eastern side of the alley (Ordinance O-366-91).
- 4. Staff has received no objections, but the following departments and organizations had these comments:
 - a. The City Engineering Department has no objections to close the above described right-of-way area. However, should this right-of-way be closed, the City will reserve easements for all drainage facilities and utilities if there are any current facilities located in or within five (5) feet of the property described herein. If any existing facilities or utilities are found not feasible to the site development or use, they may be removed and relocated, subject to City Engineering and/or other applicable easement holder review and approval.
 - b. The City's Fire Department had no comments.

WHEREAS, public notice of the hearing by the Metropolitan Planning Commission was published in the Knoxville Journal on June 29, 1991, and notice of the hearing of this matter by City Council on August 6, 1991 was published in the Knoxville News Sentinel on July 16, 1991.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE 1 CITY OF KNOXVILLE: 2 That a portion of an unnamed alley be SECTION 1: 3 closed from 23rd Street southwest to Hart Avenue, which closure 4 is more particularly described as follows: 5 6 Situated in the Fourth Civil District of Knox County, Tennessee, within Ward Twenty-two of the 7 City of Knoxville, being a portion of an unnamed alley form Twenty-third Street southwestwardly 8 approximately 250 ft, and being more fully described as follows: 9 Beginning at a point on the northwest corner of an 10 unnamed alley and Twenty-third Street as shown on Map B-5028 on file in the Department of 11 Engineering, said point also being the southeast corner of Lot 22 of the Reece Place Addition; 12 thence southwestwardly along the north right-of-way line of an unnamed alley a distance approximately 13 250 ft. to a point on the dividing line between Lots 17 and $1\overline{8}$; thence in a southeastwardly 14 direction and perpendicular to the north right-ofway line of an unnamed alley a distance 15 approximately 12 ft. to a point ont he south rightof-way line of an unnamed alley; thence northeastwardly along an unnamed alley a distance 16 approximately 250 ft. to a point at the southwest 17 corner of an unnamed alley and Twenty-third Street crossing a unnamed alley a distance of approximately 12 ft. to the point of beginning. 18 Easements are reserved for operation and 19 maintenance of any and all water lines and or sewer lines lying within or within 5 ft. of the above 20 described tract. 21 SECTION 2: After the effective date of said closure, 22 upon application of the adjacent property owners, the Mayor is 23 hereby authorized to execute and deliver quitclaim deeds 24 conveying the City's interest in the aforesaid closure in 25 26 27

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conformity with this Ordinance and as the interests of the adjacent property owners may appear.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the City requiring it.

For all rezoning, plan amendment, concept plan, use on review, right-of-way closure, and street name change applications, a sign must be posted on the subject property, consistent with the adopted Administrative Rules and Procedures.

At the time of application, staff will provide a sign(s) to post on the property as part of the application process. If the sign(s) go missing for any reason and need to be replaced, then the applicant will be responsible for picking up a new sign(s) from the Planning offices. The applicant will be charged a fee of \$10 for each replacement sign.

LOCATION AND VISIBILITY

The sign must be posted in a location that is clearly visible from vehicles traveling in either direction on the nearest adjacent/fróntage street. If the property has more than one street frontage, then the sign should be placed along the street that carries more traffic. Planning staff may recommend a preferred location for the sign to be posted at the time of application.



TIMING

The sign(s) must be posted 15 days before the scheduled Planning Commission public hearing and must remain in place until the day after the meeting. In the case of a postponement, the sign can either remain in place or be removed and reposted 15 days before the next Planning Commission meeting.
