FOR CLOSURE:

Unfinished alley way is a hazard and liability to the city. City doesn't want to spend the money to fill and pave 100 ft of unfinished alleyway. Both property owners shall take responsibility for the repairs after the

alley is closed and all rights are passed to both property owners.

DEPARTMENT-UTILITY

REPORTS:

KUB and the City Engineering Department have requested to retain any

easements that may be in place.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

▶ Approve the request to close the unnamed alley between the southeast corner of parcel 094BB003 and southwest corner of parcel 094BB002, subject to retaining all easements, since closure would not adversely affect surrounding properties.

COMMENTS:

- 1. This request is to close an unimproved and unnamed alley between the southeast corner of parcel 094BB003 to its western terminus at the southwest corner of parcel 094BB002. Closing this right-of-way would not negatively impact surrounding properties, as all surrounding parcels have access to the streets on which they are addressed. All abutting property owners signed the canvass form in agreement with the closure request.
- 2. The portion of the alley requested for closure is located at the end of the alley. The developed portion of the alley terminates near the point where closure is requested. As such, closure of this portion does not negatively impact the connectivity provided by the alley.
- 3. The City Engineering Department had these comments:

The City Engineering Department has no objections to close the above-described right-of-way area. However,

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should this right-of-way be closed, the City will reserve easements for all drainage facilities and utilities, if there are any current facilities, located in or within five (5) feet of the property described herein. No easements are reserved if there are no current facilities within the closure area. If any existing facilities or utilities are found not feasible to the site development or use, they may be removed and relocated, subject to City Engineering and/or other applicable easement holder review and approval.


4. The Knoxville Utilities Board had these comments:


We have reviewed our records and, as far as we have been able to determine, KUB has no existing utility facilities located within the subject right-of-way area and we have no objection to the requested closure. However, KUB does not release and hereby retains all easements and rights for existing facilities, whether or not identified in our research.

- 5. The following departments had no objections to the requested closure:

- iii. Tennessee Department of Transportation

If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 1/23/2024 and 2/6/2024. If denied, Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council. The date of the appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal a Planning Commission decision in the City.



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Sign Posting & Removal Requirement

Revised April 2021

The Administrative Rules and Procedures of the Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission require a sign to be posted on the property for each application subject to consideration by the Planning Commission, including the following applications: rezoning, plan amendment, concept plan, use on review/special use, planned development, right-of-way closure, and name change.



The required public notice sign(s) will be provided by Planning to the applicant when an application is submitted. If an application is submitted electronically, Planning staff will post the required sign. If a replacement sign(s) is needed, the applicant is responsible for picking up the new sign(s) from Planning and will be charged \$10 for each replacement.

LOCATION AND VISIBILITY

The sign must be posted on the nearest adjacent/frontage street and in a location clearly visible to vehicles traveling in either direction. If the property has more than one street frontage, the sign should be placed along the street that carries more traffic. Planning staff may recommend a preferred location for the sign to be posted at the time of application.

TIMING

The sign(s) must be posted **not less than 12 days prior to the scheduled Planning Commission public hearing** and must remain in place until the day after the meeting. In the case of a postponement, the sign can either remain in place or be removed and reposted not less than 12 days prior to the next Planning Commission meeting. The applicant is responsible for removing the sign after the application has been acted upon by the Planning Commission.
