APPLICANT'S REASON FOR CHANGE:	TDOT realilgned a portion of Topside Road to cross Alcoa Highway. A name is needed for the original alignment to avoid duplication.		

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the name change from Topside Road to Scenic River Road as requested by the Knox County Engineering and Public Works.

COMMENTS:

 The applicant has proposed changing the street name of Topside Road to Scenic River Road because of a recent right-of way realignment by TDOT. A portion of Topside Road was realigned to cross Alcoa Highway. The old segment of Topside Road located on the west side of Alcoa Highway now needs a new name.
 Two names were proposed by residents in the area. All property owners adjacent to the subject street section were provided the opportunity to vote for the new street name. The name 'Scenic River Road' was selected based on the majority vote.

3. Addressing staff has approved the proposed street name. Three addresses along the old section of Topside Road have already been readdressed as Scenic River Road.

4. Staff has received no objections to the renaming of this right-of-way.

5. The name change meets all requirements of the City of Knoxville's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23, Article IV, Section 23-108.

The right-of-way is located across both City of Knoxville and Knox County jurisdictions. If approved, this item will be forwarded to Knoxville City Council for action on 1/23/2024 and 2/6/2024, and to Knox County Commission on 1/22/2024. If denied, Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission's action is final, unless the action to deny is appealed to Knoxville City Council or Knox County Commission. The date of the

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appeal hearing will depend on when the appeal application is filed. Appellants have 15 days to appeal a Planning Commission decision in the City, and 30 days in the County.

RE: PROPOSED STREET NAME CHANGE FOR TOPSIDE ROAD

Dear Property Owner:

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is widening Alcoa Highway (State Route 115/US 129) from Little River to Maloney Road, which includes the realignment of Topside Road over Alcoa Highway. To ensure timely emergency response and eliminate a duplicate street name, a new street name is needed for a small section of Topside Road. The enclosed map identifies the portion of Topside Road to be given a new name.

All property owners adjacent to this section of Topside Road are being provided the opportunity to vote for the new street name. Two names were proposed by residents in the area. Coach Majors Road was proposed in honor of Coach Johnny Majors, UT's head football coach from 1977 to 1992. Scenic River Road was suggested due to the road's proximity to the river. You may vote for either street name or you may write-in another name to be reviewed. Please include your name and address with your vote.

Sign Posting & Removal Requirement

Revised April 2021

The Administrative Rules and Procedures of the Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission require a sign to be posted on the property for each application subject to consideration by the Planning Commission, including the following applications: rezoning, plan amendment, concept plan, use on review/special use, planned development, right-of-way closure, and name change.



The required public notice sign(s) will be provided by Planning to the applicant when an application is submitted. If an application is submitted electronically, Planning staff will post the required sign. If a replacement sign(s) is needed, the applicant is responsible for picking up the new sign(s) from Planning and will be charged \$10 for each replacement.

LOCATION AND VISIBILITY

The sign must be posted on the nearest adjacent/frontage street and in a location clearly visible to vehicles traveling in either direction. If the property has more than one street frontage, the sign should be placed along the street that carries more traffic. Planning staff may recommend a preferred location for the sign to be posted at the time of application.

TIMING

The sign(s) must be posted **not less than 12 days prior to the scheduled Planning Commission public hearing** and must remain in place until the day after the meeting. In the case of a postponement, the sign can either remain in place or be removed and reposted not less than 12 days prior to the next Planning Commission meeting. The applicant is responsible for removing the sign after the application has been acted upon by the Planning Commission.
