Subject: 2-B-23-OB: FY 2023 Budget Amendment # 2 Request

RECOMMENDATION

The Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission Executive Committee recommends approval of a FY 2023 budget amendment to add a contractual expense line item for "Plat Review Services" in the amount of \$50,000 to assist staff in review of plats filed with Knoxville Knox County Planning.

BACKGROUND

Due to staff changes over the past several months and the high number of plats submitted for review there has been a need to hire the services of an outside consultant to assist in this review. Planning retained the services of Cannon and Cannon Inc (CCI) in August of 2022 to assist in plat review.

Planning's Financial Policies and Procedures requires any expenditure above \$25,000 and not in the approved budget, be submitted to the Planning Commission for approval. The total contract with CCI will be greater than \$25,000 and will not exceed \$50,000.
