

I would like for you to deny this request. I attended the meeting that Angelic Ministries held at Grace Baptist Church as well as many other concerned citizens. It was unanimous that Angelic Ministries was not able to answer all of our questions or provide information to our questions as to how certain issues would be handled.

It is clear that this is an experiment in our community since they do not have currently a same exact facility (Boarding House). They don't have a history of success or failure with a boarding house. This is an experiment in our community and not necessarily something they are experts at. They have no proven record of success with a boarding house. Their programs are internally created by them, not by accredited physicians, psychologists and behavioral health specialist. They are flying by the seat of their pants making it up as they go along.

Their founder didn't attend the meeting and obviously was not interested in any of the community's concerns, how do we know that she is an active participant in her own project/experiment?

This is changing the face of our community where my family and many others decided to make a home and put down roots. Some have lived in their houses and are second and third generations in their homes.

This facility is less than .03 miles from a daycare facility and even closer as a neighbor to neighboring residents. The safety of the neighboring residents is what we ask you to consider and deny this request. Angelic Ministries does not have a proven record with a Boarding House, they were unable to explain and tell us how issues would be resolved and what procedures they had in place was evident none. Please do not let this "experiment" happen in our community.

Consider yourself, your wives, your elderly mothers and fathers, your sisters and brothers, your daughters and sons, your grandchildren and if they lived in a community where this was going to be built? Would you rule in favor of this within your own neighborhood?

Conflicts are going to arise, they told us that the residents would be there because they wanted to but they couldn't tell us what for certain would happen if that resident decided to relapse and leave the facility? They are adults and cannot be contained in a facility and held, that is against the law. They have the right to leave the facility and there are many residents in the area.

This facility is not near any sidewalks and public transportation. They say that the residents all go to the main facility downtown to work, what if boarding house resident is sick? They won't be going

downtown, what is the protocol, they couldn't and didn't tell us. There are too many things that are not outlined for policies and procedures of a facility like this.

Please deny this request.
