

Dear Commission,

I hope this finds you well. I am writing to you in regard to File Number 5-G-21-UR, which proposes an indoor/outdoor storage facility to be built on 9091, 9103, and 9105 Middlebrook Pike (Parcel ID 105 086,087 & 07801). This particular lot(s) is in the middle of a residential area. There are neighborhoods surrounding the land for this proposed storage building on almost all sides. This section of Middlebrook is already overrun with traffic and the entrance/exit for this planned property would cause even more of a mess with cars trying to turn in and out, as well as cross traffic.

Aside from the traffic, there is a storage facility right around the corner on Old Cedar Bluff, as well as a mile (give or take) in the other direction at Middlebrook and Joe Hinton.
