I have taken the time on multiple occasions to express concern with the development around Massey Creek Neighborhood. Here I am, once again, fighting to make sure that we sustain the quaint and peaceful neighborhood that drew us to Massey Creek originally. The appeal of Massey Creek has long since been the long entrance of our neighborhood that creates a setting like no other in Hardin Valley.

Yet here we are again, fighting to keep Mission Hill, peaceful and safe for our families. As Hardin Valley continues to grow, so does the traffic. The more development that we see in the area the less appealing it will become for all of us.

My main concerns however are specifically to Mission Hill and the proposal of 5 houses with connecting driveways.
