I am a concerned homeowner that lives off Andes Road and I have a child I bring to school every morning on an already dangerous two-lane road. Andes Road is known as a cut-through road to get to Middlebrook Pike from Ball Camp Pike. When Schaad Road is done being built, Andes Road will be overloaded with this new, dense neighborhood adding to the traffic, along with Schaad Road. This proposed development will have two entrances; both will need to enter/exit onto Andes no matter what. Before this development is considered, I'd like to bring up the Knox Planning 2018 Major Road Plan agenda.


Below you will find two images that was taken from the Knox Planning in the 2018 Major Road Plan. The document described the Major Road Plan for the City of Knoxville and Knox County to identify the functional classification of roadways according to the character of service they provide relative to the overall road network. Andes Road was described to be a "Major Collector" road that connects soon to be Schaad Road onto Middlebrook Pike, without having to go through the Ball Camp Elementary school zone.

<u>Major Collector:</u> "A street that primarily provides for short distance traffic movement and primarily functions to collect and distribute traffic between local streets and high-volume traffic generators and arterials. The spacing of Major Collectors is typically ½ mile and intersection spacing is typically 300 feet or greater.



Part B. Section 1 "Responsibility and Authority" clearly states Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) in Sections 13-4-302 and 13-3-402, requires municipal and regional planning commissions to adopt a major road plan prior to exercising their subdivision authority.

Part C. Section 3.04(A)(3)(a) "Right -of-Way" Preservation states that "any proposed subdivisions of property that adjoins an existing street that will result in the creation of additional lots, shall be subject to right-of-way dedication in order to bring the right-of0way closer to compliance with the Major Road Plan.

I respectfully urge the commission to visit this location. These roads are never plowed or treated in winter weather. Allowing this proposal to increase to a medium density neighborhood would be a complete disregard for the safety of the community if the current design of the outdated road stays as it is.
