## Project Summary – 7705 Sevierville Pike, South Knoxville

Thank you for the opportunity to share additional background on my rezoning request for the property at 7705 Sevierville Pike. I am requesting residential zoning at 5 dwelling units per acre (5 DU/acre) for this 5.69-acre parcel, which would allow approximately 28 single-family homes. The attached concept plan has been previously reviewed by staff and shows a straightforward, efficient layout with a single cul-de-sac. The intent of this community is to fill a growing need for attainable, low-maintenance single-level housing in South Knoxville. The homes are designed as ranch-style, single-story residences with small, manageable yards and an HOA structure that maintains common areas and minimizes owner upkeep. This type of neighborhood provides an excellent option for: Older adults looking to downsize but remain in the area, Homeowners seeking new, energy-efficient homes with minimal maintenance, and Those preferring one-level living in a stable, owner-occupied community. The property's gentle topography supports slab-on-grade construction, improving accessibility and affordability. While staff has recommended a reduction to 4 DU/acre, I believe that 5 DU/acre better supports the intended product type and the housing needs of this area. At the lower density, the lots become too large to sustain the maintenance-light model that appeals to the target homeowners. I respectfully ask for your consideration of the 5 DU/acre request to enable a practical, well-designed neighborhood that aligns with current housing trends and community needs.
